

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

1- VISA

The **OFFICINA DE EXTRANJERÍA (OEX)** provides advice on visa requirements for students who may need a visa to study in Spain, via the following link:

- **Citizens from European member states** may enter in Spain with a valid passport or identity card.
- **Citizens from non-EU countries** will need to enquire before departure at the Spanish embassy or consulate whether they need a visa to enter Spain.

If you are a **non-European student with a visa from another EU member state**, you must take into account that it is not enough to stay in Spain for more than 90 days, and a Spanish visa is required.

2- ACCOMMODATION

Although UPM-ETSIME does not provide direct support for the accommodation of incoming students, here we provide several web addresses or contacts that can serve as a guide for your accommodation.
